

POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

The powers and duties of a board of education of a central school district are set forth generally in Sections 1604,1709 and 1804 of the Education Law.

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education is a body corporate established according to the laws of New York State. Its members are considered local officials when they perform their duties regarding educational matters, as set forth in the New York State Constitution and the Education Law of New York State.

No individual member of the board of education has the right to exercise the authority of the board.
