Materials & information needed to complete the FAFSA is listed on back.

List to bring to file FAFSA

- 2017 Federal and State tax return copies for parent(s) and student
- 2017 w-2's for parent(s) and student
 - Student license #

Data they should have on-hand:

- Father, Mother and student name, social security number and dates of birth
- If anyone in the household received any of these benefits:
 - Supplemental security income
 - Food stamps
 - Free or reduced price school lunch
 - TANF
 - WIC
- Amount of 2017 Child Support PAID (if any)
- Amount of 2017 Child Support RECEIVED (if any)
- Amount of 2017 Combat Pay received (if any)
- Amount of 2017 Tax Exempt Interest Income (if any)
- Amount of 2017 untaxed pensions or IRA distributions or Worker's compensation received
- Amount currently in cash and savings/checking accounts
- Current value of investments, such as stocks or bonds
- Value of property that is not their primary residence, and the current debt (if any) on that property
- Value and debt of any business that is owned by parent (or student)
- For those that expect they will also need to file a Profile, the estimated market value of their home and their current debt on their home
