# **THE 2018-2019 BUDGET**

The Budget for the 2018 - 2019 school year is not to exceed **\$20,569,913**. This is an increase of **1.5%** in the tax levy.

#### **PROPOSITION NO. 1**

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED: That the Board of Education of the Berlin Central School District, Rensselaer County, New York, is hereby authorized to purchase in fiscal year 2018-2019 one(1) 66 passenger bus and expend a gross sum not to exceed \$125,000. Which said total sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, may be raised by issue of obligations of the district therefore in accordance with the education law and local finance law.

# **BOARD OF EDUCATION SEATS**

#### **Applications for Absentee Ballots**

Applications for absentee ballots can be requested by qualified voters if the voter is unable to appear in person to vote due to illness, physical disability, hospitalization; because of duties, occupation, business or studies outside of the county or town; vacation. Absentee ballot applications can be obtained from the District Clerk. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk by 5:00 PM, on **Tuesday**, **May 15, 2018**.
