Dear Graduating Seniors:



This scholarship award will be given to one qualified student from each of the four counties represented by RC 10 (Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Washington). Funds are paid at the end of the first semester of freshman year of college. Upon receipt of a successful fall semester transcript by March 15, 2021, funds will be issued directly to the scholarship recipient.

Each student will indicate his/her intention to become an educator by completing our application. The student is responsible for assuring that all of the materials are postmarked by the March 20 deadline.

RETIREE COUNCIL 10 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Application must include the following:

1. Completed application form—attached sheet.
2. **Applicants must submit in a sealed envelope an official transcript showing three-year average, rank in class, senior mid-year grades, and senior year courses in progress labeled as Attachment 1.**
3. List your advanced placement, honors, accelerated, New Visions, college courses, and/or International Baccalaureate courses taken during your entire high school career labeled as **Attachment 2.**
4. List your in-school activities and leadership by year labeled as **Attachment 3.**
5. List your out-of-school community activities and leadership/service by year labeled as **Attachment 4.**
6. List employment experience labeled as **Attachment 5.**
7. Essay on the **designated topic** *answered in English by the applicant, printed double spaced in 12 point type, and not to exceed 1,000 words* labeled as **Attachment 6.**

Why I have chosen to enter education as a career field.

8. Response to **ONE** of the **designated questions** *answered in English by the applicant, printed double spaced in 12 point type, and not to exceed 1,000 words* labeled as **Attachment 7.**

Sometimes an experience or event can have a major impact on your life.

and explain how it has affected your thinking or actions.**

OR

One person can be an important influence in your life.

**Describe how one person, living or deceased, has had
an impact on your actions and thinking.**

9. First Letter of Recommendation (may be a letter used with your college application) labeled as **Attachment 8.**
10. Second Letter of Recommendation (may be a letter used with your college application) labeled as **Attachment 9.**
11. Finalists may be asked to come for an interview; and if asked, must do so to be considered for final selection.
12. Funds are paid at the end of the first semester of freshman year of college. Upon receipt of a successful fall semester transcript by March 15, 2021, funds will be issued directly to the scholarship recipient.

The burden of submission of all materials will be on the student, not the counselor. The student is responsible for assuring that all of the materials are postmarked by the deadline.
