- 3) Student must enroll as a full-time student to receive award.

 - a) Complete, signed application.
 - b) Two written recommendations.
 - One submitted from a teacher
 - One submitted as a personal recommendation
 - c) Official transcript of grades.

Awards:

- 1) Scholarship is non-renewable.
- 2) Applications will be reviewed, and the Scholarship Committee of the Capital District Chapter #261 of NAWIC will select the winner. The Committee will consider the applicant's interest in construction, grades, extra-curricular activities, employment experience and written recommendations.
- 3) All applicants selected as semi-finalists will be subject to a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
