Protocols for Health screening

The Berlin Central School district has developed the following protocols for health screenings of students, faculty, staff, vendors and visitors in accordance with CDC guidelines.

1. Students riding the bus-on days where they are expected to be on campus, a daily health screening that includes a temperature check must be completed at home and reported to the app provided by the district. In order to ride the bus, the screening results must be entered into the app provided by the school TBD for MS/HS students and TBD for BES students. Students must remain home if failed health screening. Further information will be provided. Students will be allowed to board the bus if they can show the bus driver they have completed the screening results after the above mentioned time.
2. Students arriving via drop off/driving self- will be required to report to the health screening station prior to entering the building. If they have not completed the daily health survey at home and recorded the results via app, they will be required to complete the daily health survey before entering the building. The covid rep will be notified of any student that has not completed the daily health screening. The covid rep will ensure that any student that did not complete the health screening at home will have the screening completed upon arrival to campus.
3. Student drivers and students being dropped off by parents/guardians at the MS/HS must arrive and may enter the building between 7:30 am and 7:45 am (before busses arrive) or 8:00 am after the busses have unloaded. Students being dropped at the elementary school may enter the front of the building after 8:50 am.
4. Before leaving home, staff will be required to complete the daily online screening survey via the app. Staff MUST stay home if they are not feeling well and have failed the screening survey . Staff will notify their supervisor.
5. Visitors/vendors-will be required to stop at the screening station to take temperature and complete the daily online health survey before entering the building. Access will be denied if visitor/vendor answers fail the health screening survey.

Please remember information is fluid and subject to change.
