Grades & Testing:

- Grades count this year as in any other year. See the parent handbook for a breakdown of course percentages.
- Regents tests are cancelled for January, but are on for June (as far as we know).
 - Juniors typically take the US History Regents exam & the ELA Regents exam.
 - Seniors may have Regents tests to do, depending on the classes they are in & whether they have failed a previous Regents.
- Advanced Placement tests are also still on as of right now. Those happen in the spring.

- Students must keep up on their work & attend Zoom meetings.
 - Zoom attendance See the "Grade 11/12 Class Expectations Quick Reference" document that is posted on the website to know what each teacher expects.
 - Teachers provide necessary instruction and often walk students through assignments in Zoom meetings. Attending them counts towards students' attendance and makes a big difference to whether students understand and complete the work.
 - Absences can be earned back if students make up work. Each teacher is free to set their own parameters as to how that is done. Contact your student's teacher directly or see the syllabus if your student needs to earn back absences.

Wednesdays

- These are part of our schedule and count as school days. Any work assigned has to be completed. Teachers may require students to attend office hours on Wednesdays or ask them to check in only if they need help. This could be posted on Schoology or as an invitation on your student's Google Calendar.
 - Email individual teachers, check syllabi, or see the "Grade 11/12 Class Expectations Quick Reference" to learn what your student should do on Wednesdays.

Communication

- Familiarize yourself with the Schoology calendar, "upcoming assignments" section, message function, and updates tab in Schoology.
- Parents and students can email teachers or message them on Schoology.

What is expected for PE Credit

Hybrid Students--One day of in-person participation each week with appropriate PE attire (sneakers, shorts/sweatpants/yoga pants,etc.) One day of at-home physical activity for at least 30 minutes and record your activity on the PE Activity Tracker found on Schoology.

Remote Students--Three days of physical activity (M,W,F or Tu,W,Th) for at least 30 minutes and record your activity on the PE Activity Tracker found on Schoology.
