Project Safe Point began in 2008 in response to an unmet need for sterile syringe access and harm reduction services in the Capital Region. The program started with a needle exchange site in Albany and has grown to include mobile needle exchange sites in Schenectady and Troy. Project Safe Point is a part of the Catholic Charities Care Coordination Services program. Project Safe Point follows a harm reduction model and they work to offer other services as well besides just needle exchange.
