When crossing the road make eye contact with drivers to make sure they see you!



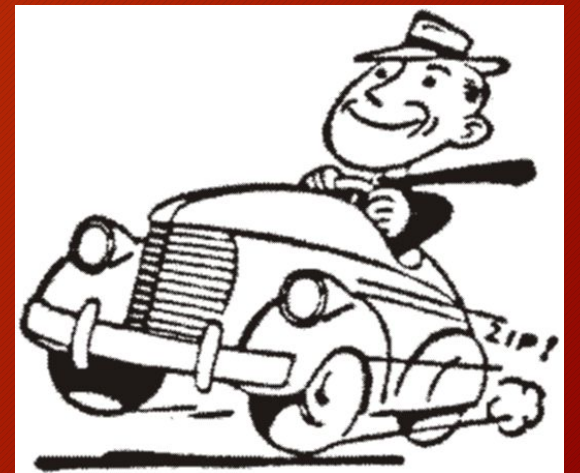
Halloween Safety Tips

Halloween Safety Tips

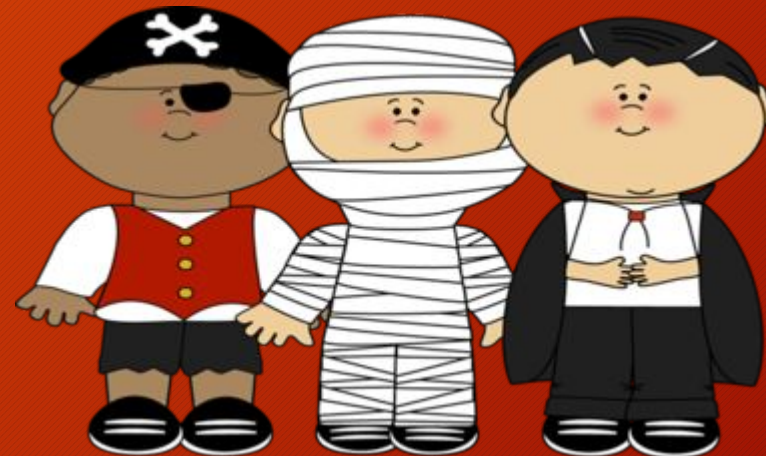
If you choose to wear a mask...
