 - a. Soccer Tournament Review
 - i. Profit
 - 1. Approximately \$2,000 (20% to General Booster fund, 40% to Girls Soccer, 40% to Boys Soccer)
 - ii. How can we improve next year?
 - 1. Scheduling (later in September)
 - 2. T-shirts
 - a. Cost-cutting look into local/alternative options

- b. Color (feedback from Girls Varsity Soccer team)
 - i. Girls requested black, if possible
- c. Two-sided t-shirt worked well in selling to other teams in tourney – if we can finalize teams who will be participating in tournament in advance, we can send out pre order forms.
- 3. Inclusion of food truck
 - a. \$300 profit
 - b. Rolling out of \$5 off tickets
 - i. Did not work well some players might not have received tickets; need to improve
 - c. Undecided; table discussion for now and reevaluate in Summer '24
- 4. Revamping menu?
 - a. Offering selection of fruit in addition to other snacks
 - b. Gatorade was more popular than soda
 - c. Make sure to create larger menu so customers can see pricing/menu options more clearly
- 5. Ways to improve set up/take down
 - a. Perhaps different stations/tables with multiple cash boxes to avoid workers running into each other
 - Perhaps use Sterno and warmers for hot dishes instead of multiple Crockpots
 - c. Try to organize how we put things away better and hope we don't have a thunderstorm/tornado next year!
- 6. Leftovers from tournament (soda, water, burgers, hot dogs, chips that will expire before Mountain Madness)
 - a. Food inventory?
 - Candy has water and Shannon has burgers, hot dogs, soda water, candy, chips, etc.
 - Sell snacks/drinks at remaining home games New
 Lebanon should be fine but need to check with senior class at Berlin games
- b. Rolling out of new BNL mascot, colors, and apparel
 - i. Setting up new apparel store with BSN Sports
 - 1. Booster Club will be responsible and this will be a fundraiser for us

c. Holiday Raffle

- i. Online, paper tickets, or combination
 - Combination but instead of online option with service fees, people can reach out over Messenger/email and raffle tickets will be filled out on their behalf and photos sent to them. People can pay via Venmo/send in cash or check
 - 2. 31 days of prizes in December gift cards, new logo apparel, and
 - a. Goal to sell up to 1,000 tickets with 200 tickets being our break even point
 - 3. Shannon to order customized raffle tickets
 - 4. Flyers in Berlin and NL elementary and MSHS
- ii. Timing
 - 1. Start selling October 1st and sell through November 30th
- iii. Events besides Fall Fest (10/14) at which we can sell tickets
 - 1. Berlin Fire Breakfasts (last Saturdays of month), Grafton Christmas Tree Festival (November), NL Craft Fair, etc.
 - a. Need volunteers; perhaps another volunteer opportunity for students with BC supervision
 - 2. Ask stores to sell tickets (Maverick's, The Grafton Store, Rocky Hill Country store, etc.)?
 - 3. Parents who would like tickets to sell can request them
- d. Paper thank yous (in addition to social media thank yous)
 - i. Order thank yous
- e. Emails to Fall coaches explaining procedures to request funds and providing current balances
 - i. Shannon/Candy will send emails to Fall coaches (every level) to provide updated account balances and reminder of procedures to request funds
