The primary role of the internship will be direct voter outreach, which can be done in a campaign office, in the field, or remotely, depending on the circumstances. This internship opportunity is available in State Senate districts across all geographical regions of the state, giving you the freedom to choose a location that suits you best.

No previous campaign experience is necessary. We strongly encourage individuals from diverse backgrounds to apply.
