THINGS TO CONSIDER

ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S INTERESTS & FAMILY PREFERENCES

- What is the camp's program emphasis?
- What is the daily schedule at the camp, and does that fit your schedule?
- Will the activities interest your child?
- Will your child have a chance to learn new skills and work on old ones?
- Is there a difference in the programs offered for younger and older children?
- Does the daily schedule include quiet and active times, group and independent activities?
- Is there a discount for siblings attending the same program?
- If financial considerations are keeping you from planning a camp experience for your child, inquire about sliding scale fees or scholarships. Don't be shy!
- How does the camp handle special needs?
- Is there a nurse on staff? Are special foods available for those with restricted diets?

ABOUT THE STAFF

- Does the staff have experience working with school-age children?
- Have they received specialized training?
- How many children does each counselor supervise?
- Is additional staff added for field trips and other activities that call for extra supervision (swimming, for example)?
- Will someone be supervising your child at all times?
- Is anyone on the staff trained to handle medical emergencies? Are there written health, safety, and emergency rules? What is the camp's policy when a child gets sick or has an accident?
- What are the ages of the camp counselors?
- How does the staff handle behavioral or disciplinary problems?

ABOUT THE RULES

- Can parents visit the camp at any time? Are there any special activities scheduled that include parents?
- What are the camp's rules about communication with children during the day?
- Are questions and comments from parents encouraged?

ABOUT THE FACILITY

- Does the camp seem safe, well-maintained, and clean?
- Is the outdoor area large enough for sports and activities?
- Is the indoor space large enough for the children in bad weather?
- Do the activity areas have enough materials and equipment to make them interesting?
- Do campers have enough space to work and play in groups as well as individually?
- If the camp provides transportation, where and when are children picked up and dropped off? Will a staff member be there to supervise them? Do staff members ever ride on the bus with the campers?
- What does the camp/program fee include? Are there any extra charges?

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR OVERNIGHT CAMPS

- How far from home do you want your child to go? Do you want to be able to visit?
- Does your child want to stay overnight for two weeks or more?
- How much money do you want to spend?
- Would your child feel more comfortable with children he/she already know or would they like to meet new ones? Is there a friend your child would like to bring along?
- What is the food like? Ask for sample menus.
- What is the percentage of participants and staff who return each year?

TIPS TO COMBAT HOMESICKNESS

- Combat homesickness by planning. Involve everyone in selecting the camp and talk openly about the possibility of homesickness.
- Try an overnight at a relative's home.
- Learn the camp's policy on phone calls and visits before your child leaves for camp. When contacting your child, don't go into great detail, as they might feel they're missing something back home.
- Keep in touch by giving your child a pre-addressed stamped envelope or postcard so they can keep you informed of their activities.
- Send a note to the camp so it will be there when your child arrives. It lets the young camper know that you have not forgotten them.
- Don't worry. Camp counselors are trained to recognize and deal with symptoms of homesickness.

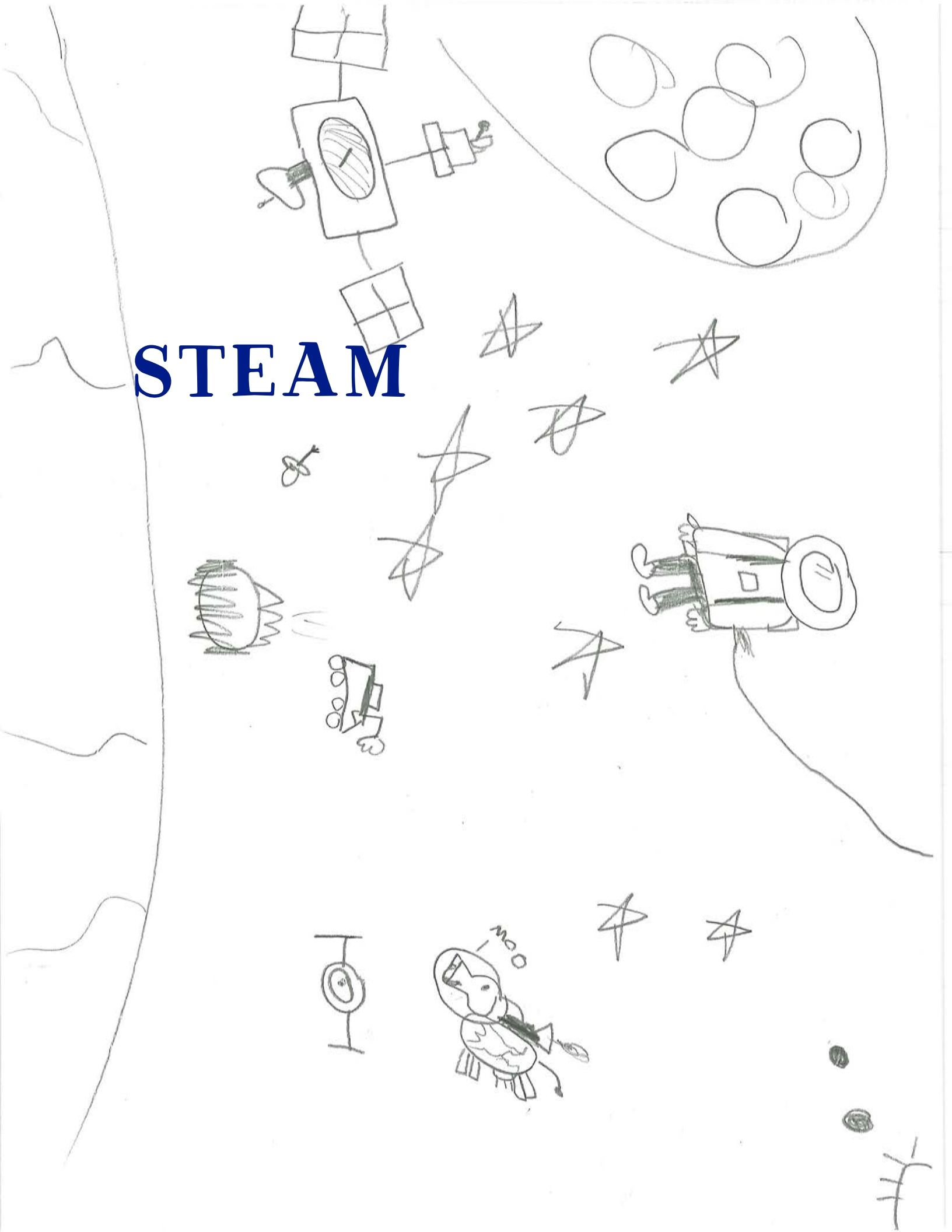

Need help paying for child care?

The New York State Office of Children and Family Services' Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) provides eligible families across New York State with financial assistance for child care. CCAP promotes early childhood learning and development while allowing parents/caretakers to work, get training or go to school. The CCAP is administered by local departments of social services (LDSSs) in 57 counties and NYC.

Are you eligible?

- You could be eligible if your income is less than the income eligibility level and you:
- Are receiving public assistance; or
- Work a minimum of 10 hours per week; or
- Are going to school or a vocational program; or
- Are seeking employment; and
- Your child is one of the following:
 - Younger than 13
 - Younger than 18 with special needs; or
 - Under court supervision
 - Younger than 19 in a secondary school; or equivalent program and has special needs
 - Younger than 19 in a secondary school; or equivalent program and under court supervision

How do you apply?

To apply complete the following steps:

- Contact your LDSS. <https://ocfs.ny.gov/directories/localdss.php>
- Ask for a child care assistance application
- Complete the application and return it to your LDSS.
- You will need the following:
 - Identification for everyone in the household (include proof of citizenship for each child)
 - Income verification (paystubs or other documentation to prove employment and income)
 - Proof of residence
 - Work or school schedule

What happens if you are approved?

- **Choose a provider and enroll your child. You can choose any of the following types of care:**
 - Licensed day care center (permitted in NYC)
 - Registered family day care
 - Licensed group family day care
 - Registered school-age child care
 - Enrolled legally exempt child care provider
- **You may have to pay part of the child care costs (family share copay) unless you are receiving public assistance, experiencing homelessness, when such assistance is provided as a protective or preventive service, when such assistance is provided to a child in foster care or when it is a child only case.**
- **As long as you continue in an allowable activity, you will remain eligible for CCAP for 12 months, unless your household income goes above 85% of the state median income.**
