What is Schoology?

Schoology (School-uh-gee) is an easy-to-use learning management system (LMS) that connects the teachers, students, parents, content, and other systems that fuel education.

Sounds great! How do I get started?

First, you need to create an account in our school parent portal. To do this you must go to our website (berlincentral.org), click on the parents tab, and click the [parent portal registration form](#) link.

This will enable you to see contact information for your student, student schedules, attendance, discipline, progress reports, quarterly averages, major assessments, and important school related documents. It will also allow you access to teacher email addresses.

Once you have followed the directions on your registration form, and turn it into the school, you will receive instructions on how to proceed from Mrs. Barto

These instructions will help you create your password for both Schooltool and Schoology.

If you have any questions with the form, or anything to do with your login credentials, feel free to email Mrs. Barto at hbarto@berlincentral.org to assist you.

How do I login on my device?

If you are using a desktop computer, laptop, chromebook, etc... you need to go to the correct link. This is a unique link for parents.


- Option 1:

Go to berlincentral.org, click on parents, and there is a link there that says [Schoolology \(4th -12th\)](#). Click the link, and login with your credentials.

- Option 2:

Go to app.schoolology.com and login with your credentials. You can always bookmark this page.




What else can I see?

- You will have complete access to your own account as well as your child's account.
- This means you will see your own name, along with any children you have in the district under the same account.
- You can toggle back and forth between all of their accounts.
- **You may not access any other student's content though.**



What can I do in my own account?

- Your account has the ability to join professional learning communities, parental groups managed through the school, public groups, manage your own saved personal resources, and add other apps to your account.
- Realistically, you probably won't be using your **own** account for much other than to set your notifications and send or receive messages.
- To make these adjustments please click settings under the tab on the right:



How do I adjust my notifications?

After clicking on settings, choose the Notifications tab at the top of the page:




So what is my account good for???

- You can send and receive messages using the little envelope at the top of the page. You only have the ability to send messages to and from instructors in the district and you will not have access to any students.
- Realistically the best part of your account is your child's account access.
- You can choose between accounts and manage them separately.
- You do this by simply selecting the student's account you wish to view:



You are now *viewing* your child's account!

- You will not have access to submit or turn in work for your child. You can only ever view their account through the parent page.




- If you wish to assist with submissions you would need them to login to their account and help from there.

While we are still thinking about notifications...

- You have the ability to get more detailed notifications about your children's progress.
- If you click the dropdown menu on the right again, you will see that same button for settings.
- Since you are technically in a different account, it will look a bit different when you click on it this time though.
- Click notifications at the top after clicking settings this time.



While we are still thinking about notifications...

- Here you can turn your email summary on and off
- You can also change from weekly to daily emails
- You can adjust the time they are sent, and day(s)
- You can also turn on and off notifications for Overdue Submissions Email.
- The settings on the right are your default settings on all of your children's accounts.
- These are not independent for each of your children.

What else can I do with Schoology other than receive notifications?

Courses

- Here you can view all of your child's Courses.

Groups

- Here you can view all of your child's Groups.

Student Activity

- Any update your child receives will be here.

Grades Report

- You can see a detailed preview of all of your child's grades by course down to the individual assignment.



Courses

- When you view courses you will see exactly what your child would see when logging in.
- You can use this feature to assist your child in navigating through their Course Materials, Updates, and Grades.
- Each Course is essentially a Virtual Classroom. As every teacher's classroom is managed a bit differently, their Virtual Classroom may be managed a little differently as well. Questions about a teacher's page and how to Navigate through it should be directed to the specific teacher (note the envelope at the bottom right side).

- If you click on Grades you will see a breakdown (as shown on the right).
- You can check the individual category grades, see the quarterly averages, and the overall course average as well.
- If you click a particular tab you can view all assignments in that particular grading category.
- Some of the assignments may be marked Excused or Missing, and may have comments on them as well.
- Again, grades may be set up a bit differently based upon the Classroom Teacher.
- You can click any assignment in here and get more detailed information about it.

Groups and Student Activity (Updates)

- Groups have no Grades or Assignments attached to them. Often times these Groups are used by teachers and students to communicate.
- This is not to say that they aren't important, but it is not something that students are held accountable for in School, so parents rarely look at these.
- You can enter groups as a parent, but any posts in a group by a student will not be visible for privacy reasons.
- Groups include activities like sports, clubs, classes, etc...
- You will see posts in the live update section of Schoology from all of your child's Groups and Courses together.
- It will also contains any district or building messages.
- Student Activity is just all of the updates from all of the courses, groups, and building messages combined.

Grade Report and Enrollments

The Grades Report tab at the top just gives you a look at **all** of your child's grades in list form.

- You can get to all of their courses from here instead of clicking into each and every course.
- It really just saves you time if you are looking for a quick view of all of their Grades by course.
- It also breaks things down exactly the same way as before, and you can click into individual assignments still too.

The Enrollments button gives you a list view of the Courses and Groups your child is a member of.

- Next to these Courses will be the Course Overall Grade.
- It is just really a list view of everything from the Courses button and Groups button combined.
- You can always click into any of these Courses and Groups at any point.
