(Grade 12)



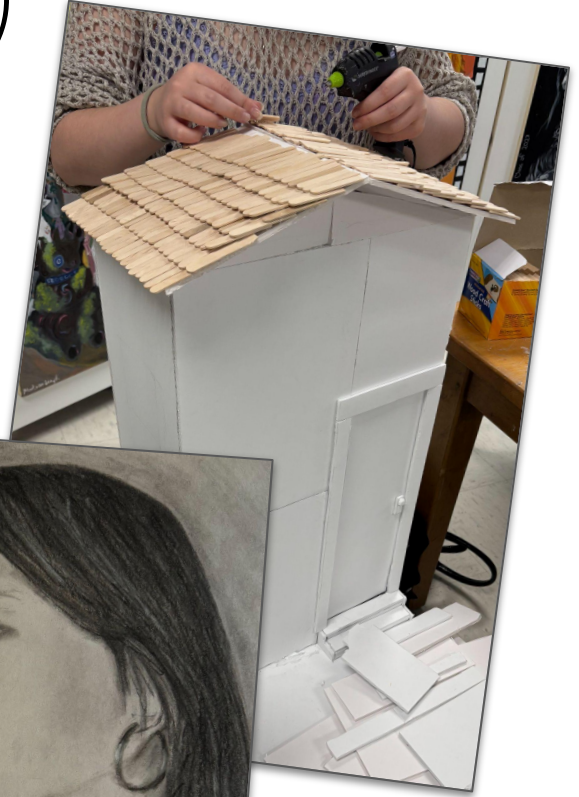
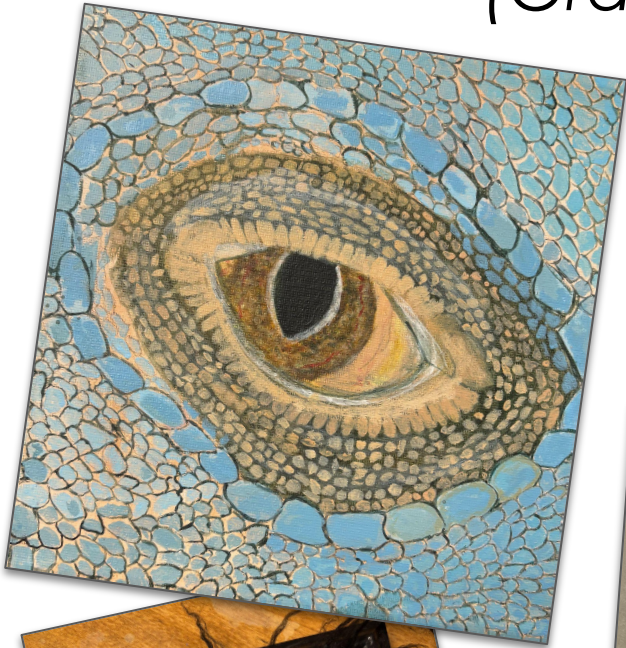

(Grade 11)



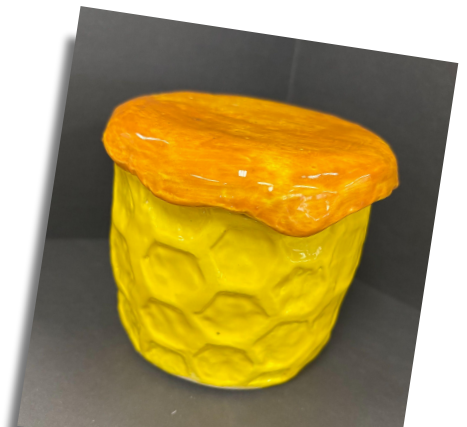

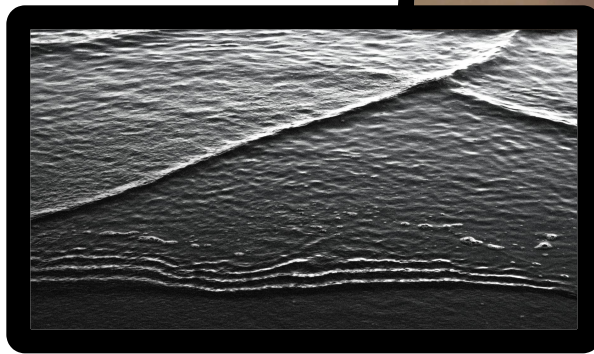
