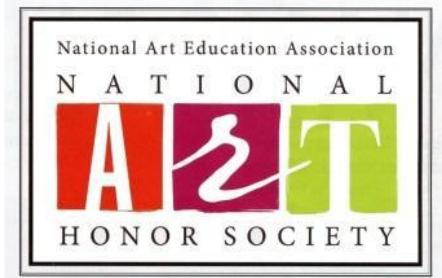


Congratulations! You have been recommended to join the Berlin High School Chapter of National Art Honor Society for NEXT School Year!

- ☐ Earned at least a B (or 80% final average) in one high school level visual arts course.
- ☐ Maintain at least a B (or 80% average) in subsequent visual arts courses taken and as a total GPA for your other classes each year to remain in good standing for the Society.
- ☐ **Attend all NAHS meetings** (approximately once per month in total) either afterschool or during a mutually-agreed upon period during the day. *Note: Mrs. Colbert understands that other commitments may conflict with NAHS meetings like sports, clubs, work or Questar schedules. You can work out an alternative plan with her if that is the case and still be an NAHS member.*
- ☐ Keeping up with all communication for NAHS through the **NAHS Group on Schoology**, listening to morning announcements etc.
- ☐ “Work” either an Art Club meeting, a fundraising event or other service for ***at least 5 hours of community service before May 15th*** volunteering your time (*either during the school day or afterschool*) to complete tasks that fellow members plan during regularly scheduled meetings.
- ☐ **Attend the NAHS Induction Ceremony** at the “Arts Alive!” Festival at the end of May/beginning of June when the Art Show is exhibited.
