What are the benefits of being in NAHS?



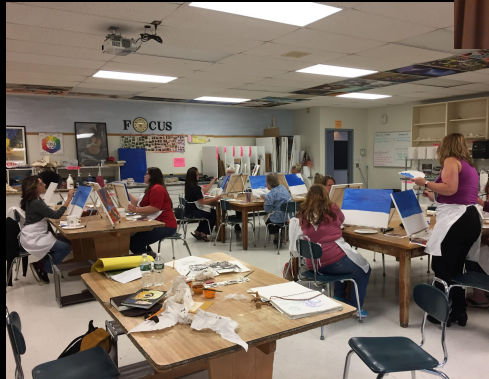
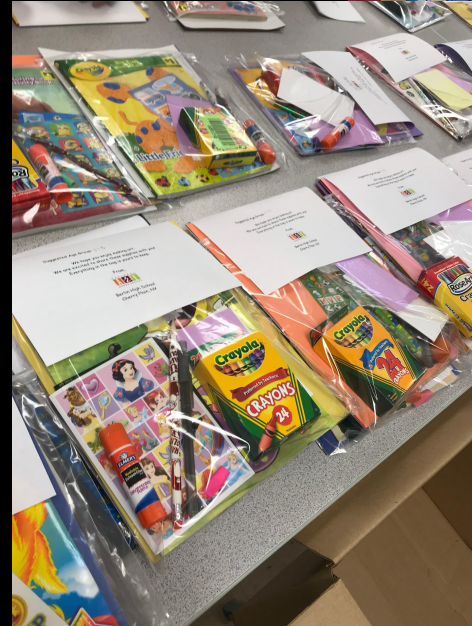
- ★ We take **field trips** to experience art in our world that give NAHS members first dibs.
- ★ Complete an annual art-related **community service** project - *this school needs a lot of murals....*
- ★ There are **scholarship opportunities** through NAEA for NAHS members only.
- ★ As a senior NAHS member, you also get a **multicolored tassel for graduation!**
- ★ **Looks great on college or career applications** because you are part of a leadership society and the community by being in NAHS.
- ★ *But most of all, being involved in the Arts in our school and surrounding community!*

What would I have to do?



- ★ **Fill out the application & be accepted!** *(once accepted, you don't have to reapply each year as long as you fulfill your other responsibilities)*
- ★ **Keep up with your grades**, in both Art and elsewhere (80% or above average) to remain in good standing.
- ★ **Attend all NAHS meetings** (approximately once per month in total) either afterschool or during a mutually-agreed upon period during the day. Note: *Mrs. Colbert understands that other commitments may conflict with NAHS meetings like sports, clubs, work or Questar schedules. You can work out an alternative plan with her if that is the case and still be an NAHS member.*
- ★ Complete at least **5 hours of community service** (opportunities will be provided for you – you don't have to find your own).
- ★ **Attend the NAHS Induction Ceremony at the "Arts Alive!"** Art Show/Festival at the end of May/beginning of June when the Art Show is exhibited.
